In order to avoid any conflicts with the State exams and vacation time, all projects are due by the dates listed below. Students will be **designing these sculptures at home and bring them to Horizons** on the following assigned days:

Day 1	March 17 <sup>th</sup>
Day 2	March 20 <sup>th</sup>
Day 3	March 21 <sup>st</sup>
Day 5	March 23 <sup>rd</sup>
Day 6	March 16 <sup>th</sup>

I will be delivering all of the sculptures to the Portledge School myself, so you will just need to make sure that your child has turned in his/her sculpture to me by the due date. The due date that is assigned to your child is the last time I will see him/her before the start of the State Exams. I have attached the specific details for the theme this year. Please make sure that your child closely follows the rules in order to be eligible for this contest.

The awards ceremony for this contest is being held on Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> (EARTH DAY)! It would be wonderful if our students can attend this ceremony, however, keep in mind that attendance at the ceremony is not required. Your child can still participate in this contest even if he/she cannot attend on April 22<sup>nd</sup>.

## Rules:

- The sculpture should be highly creative and made primarily out of recycled/upcycled materials. (Your child can use cardboard, plastic bottles, tape, glue, bottle caps, paint, markers, etc.)
- The sculpture may not exceed 15" wide by 15" tall and must be able to sit or stand independently.
- It is wonderful if your musical instrument can actually play, however it is not a requirement.
